

HOMEWORK INFORMATION

Here are some guidelines and explanations about homework. Throughout third grade, homework assignments will remain pretty consistent.

- **Math** – flashcards need to be practiced every night until all basic addition, subtraction, multiplication and division fast facts are mastered. Students are responsible for getting the next set of flashcards once a particular timed test is passed twice. At times, flashcards will need to be cut out at home.
 - PW stands for our math practice workbook. Generally one PW page will be assigned per night.
 - Take home tests are especially important as the actual test will be taken the next day.

- **Reading:** Mon. – Wed. Students will read our weekly decodable and read AR books.
- Monday night students will bring home comprehension stories to read and answer questions. They need to do both sides.
- On Thursdays anthology stories will come home to be read with a family member for our lesson assessment the following day.

- **Spelling:**
 - Mon. Write words one time
 - Tues. Divide by syllables. Words are written with a dash (-) between syllables.
 - Wed. ABC order. Students will write their spelling words in alphabetical order.
 - Thurs. Write each word two times with the vowels in a different color. They also need to take a practice spelling test at home.

Please keep this page in your child's homework binder and refer to it when needed. By no means does it take the place of logging homework every day. Students are ultimately responsible for getting homework logged correctly and turned in. Parents - please remember to go over homework and initial your child's binder every day. Once you have done this, please have your child place all homework in the pocket in their binder and put it in their backpack so it is not forgotten.
